Expectations differ depending on whether PSTs take this placement as a novice (first) or a consolidating (second) placement. Below are the novice placement expectations. PSTs should discuss these expectations with their Supervising Teacher. PSTs should also complete a lesson plan for any lesson they will teach using the La Trobe Lesson Plan Template. Provide the plan to the Supervising Teacher the day before delivering the lesson (or earlier, if requested) for discussion.
