10-day placement in a Primary or Secondary setting

Alongside the expectations listed below, PSTs should also have thoroughly read the Professional Experience Handbook and the placement subject's Subject Learning Guide and LMS site.

Expectations differ depending on whether PSTs take this placement as a novice (first) or a consolidating (second) placement. Below are the novice placement expectations for Nexus students enrolled in NSW. PSTs should discuss these expectations with their Supervising Teacher. PSTs should also complete a lesson plan for any lesson they will teach using the La Trobe Lesson Plan Template. Provide the plan to the Supervising Teacher the day before delivering the lesson (or earlier, if requested) for discussion.
